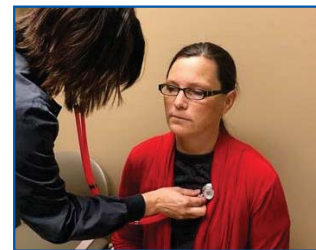

2018 was a year of new partnerships and innovative solutions to community needs. Learn more about the new programming facilitated by United Way.

CLOTHING CLOSET



Since March of 2004, thanks to a partnership with the South Dakota Human Services Center (SD HSC), a project called The Clothing Closet has offered community members who are struggling to make ends meet **the opportunity to receive free, quality clothing in a dignified, and welcoming space.** Since its inception, thousands of individuals of all ages have been served by this critical community service.

This year, due to the increased need, a more accessible location for those needing clothing, as well as the manpower required, SD HSC and United Way started a conversation on how to better serve the public. Led by United Way, partners have gathered to discuss how our community can continue this critical program in the most efficient and cost-effective manner.

Thanks to a **strong partnership with Servant Hearts Clinic**, donated space on 3rd Street will house the program, United Way will be managing costs associated with programming, logistics of collection and distribution, and managing volunteer groups to help with collection and customer service.

United Way will continue its relationship with SD HSC, local retailers and other non-profits to create a seamless transition of services for those seeking clothing with the hopes of re-opening The Clothing Closet, at the new location, in the spring of 2019.

STUDENT UNITED WAY



Created in the fall of 2018, the mission of Mount Marty College Student United Way is for every MMC student, no matter career or educational path, to find value and need to volunteer and to create solutions within the health, financial stability and educational needs of MMC and the greater Yankton community.

Student UW IMPACT:

Big Red Bookshelf: Students participated in 15 minutes of philanthropy projects creating inspirational bookmarks to be placed in donated children's books.

Yankton Community Feast: Students learned more about the annual Thanksgiving meal open to all community members and created centerpieces to help create a welcoming space for all.

Adopt a Family: With the assistance of the faculty and staff of Mount Marty College, students collected, purchased and wrapped gifts and necessities for families in need through United Way's Adopt a Family program.

OPPORTUNITIES

BIG FRIEND LITTLE FRIEND



Due to recent challenges with continuity within the Big Friend Little Friend mentoring program, the sustainability of the agency was uncertain. Therefore, to maintain and add a broader range of services to a larger group of individuals, **BFLF merged with United Way** and became a program component per a Memorandum of Understanding agreement effective May 1, 2018.

BFLF is designed to give young people the opportunity to gain a one to one friendship with a positive and sincere adult mentor. Research confirms that quality mentoring relationships have powerful positive effects on young people in a variety of personal, academic, and professional situations.

Thanks to a recent partnership with the Yankton School District, **United Way BFLF launched an In-School Mentoring program** in January 2019, piloting in both Webster and Stewart Elementary.

Yankton School District Superintendent, Dr. Wayne Kindle is pleased to be collaborating with United Way's BFLF In-School Mentoring Program. "We know there are youth in our elementary schools who would appreciate and benefit from an adult mentor from our community. We give thanks to those adult mentors who are providing their time and talents to share with our young kids."

Lauren Hanson, United Way Executive Director is enthusiastic about the merger and In School Mentoring launch, "**our mission is to change lives by mobilizing not only resources but people, volunteers, to improve our community.** There is an opportunity to do more, serve more, and make a larger impact together than any of us could do alone."

STEP FORWARD TO PREVENT SUICIDE WALK

In August, Bridging Yankton hosted their second annual Step Forward to Prevent Suicide Walk and remembrance ceremony where supporters joined efforts with thousands of people to raise awareness and funds.

PROGRAMS BENEFITTED

Proceeds from Step Forward to Prevent Suicide Walk helped launch "Text 4 Hope", a suicide crisis texting line at the Yankton Middle School as well as maintain the Yankton High School's program, giving students the ability to reach out for support. Funds also helped Bridging Yankton sponsor a Yankton Middle School Courage Retreat, empowering youth to be themselves and take positive risks that make a healthy difference for themselves, their peers and their school.

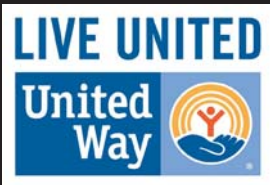
